Children's Sabbath School Social Distancing Plan for 2021

We have considered the recommendations from the Center of Disease Control and the St. Louis County Health Department and put together a plan to help reduce the spread of the Covid-19.

Masks

- 1. Children ages 2 and up are required to wear masks unless they are vaccinated.
- 2. Students will need to wear masks during Sabbath School except when eating snacks or drinking water.
- 3. All students will need to wear a clean mask into their Sabbath School class each week.
- 4. Students may not wear tied bandanas or scarfs as masks.

Bathroom and Hall use

- 1. No more than 2 students per class will be allowed in the bathrooms.
- 2. Students will keep to their right while traveling in the halls.

<u>Classroom Management</u>

- 1. Teachers will work to maintain social distancing in the classroom as they provide instruction.
- 2. Seating will be arranged with social distancing in place depending on the number of students.
- 3. Classes will be sanitized at the end of class.

Health and Safety

1. If you feel sick OR have a temperature of 99.6 or greater within the last three days, we ask that you stay home until you are fever free for 72 hours with no medicine.
