Job Description: Children's Sabbath School Leader (includes Cradle Roll, Kindergarten, Primary, Junior, and Youth)

Ministry mission: To help children know God, to hear God's Word, and to respond appropriately. The assistant leader fulfills the ministry mission by supporting the Sabbath School teachers and by teaching when asked.

Responsibilities

The leader of a children's division of the Sabbath School has the following responsibilities:

- Along with assistant(s), he or she plans and prepares Sabbath School room each quarter
- Alternates with assistant(s) in teaching the Sabbath School class. Spends adequate time in preparing for lesson during the week.
- Begins class at 9:30AM
- Works with Sabbath School Superintendent in planning special Sabbath School programs in main sanctuary
- Attends Sabbath School Council meetings when scheduled

Teaching Roles:

- Learns to lead a child to Jesus, encouraging the child in daily prayer and study.
- Learns to understand the goals of the GraceLink Sabbath School and the philosophy behind the lessons.

Time Commitment

Approximately 2-3 hours per week.
