

Job Description: Medical Ministry Team Leaders & Assistants

We are a team of trained medical professionals whose purpose is to stabilize and provide medical care in the event of an emergency with compassion and discernment. To assess the urgency of a medical situation on the premises, determine the level of care required, and arrange for those services to be provided immediately so that the health and well-being of the individual is maintained.

The most important objective of Medical Ministry Team services are to provide rapid health services that are supportive and strength-based in nature and that will save lives and decrease the risk of further loss of health, greater injury, or fatality. "Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick". Luke 5:31 It is the objective of our heavenly Father to provide for the spiritual, physical, and mental needs of his children.

Duties of the Medical Ministry Leader & Assistant:

The ministry to which a person is called when he or she becomes the Medical Ministry Leader or assistant can be described in the following ways:

1. To evaluate, intervene, and stabilize individuals who are experiencing a health emergency or urgent health situation on the premises.
2. To determine the health care needs of the individual, provide the services available until additional medical help arrives.
3. To determine if an ambulance is required to transport the individual. If so, assign one person to call for an ambulance, and another person to guide the ambulance to the appropriate doorway or entry.
4. To relinquish the care of that individual into the hands of qualified medical personnel for the continued care of the individual in crisis.

Requirements:

1. Must be licensed as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Registered Nurse (RN), or a Medical Doctor (MD).
2. Must have completed the training on the Automated External Defibrillators (AED) maintained on the premises.

Time Commitment:

Medical Ministry Team Leaders and Assistants will spend 3 to 4 months per year on call to provide services during Sabbath School, and Divine Worship Service.
